## BROOKS-MABERRY AGENT TELLS STUDENTS ABOUT EQUINE INSURANCE



**Tucson, AZ** — Race Track Industry Program students learned firsthand of the diverse equine insurance industry in a presentation by Arthur Maberry, owner of Brooks-Maberry Equine Insurance. Maberry spoke to the ANS 444: Development and Management of Racing Animals class on his job as an equine insurance agent.

Maberry gave an overview of equine insurance before describing the types of insurance available to horse owners, ranging from foal policies to those covering stallions. He also discussed the cost of insuring a horse as well as the strategies behind the process of insuring horses, both of which will likely prove valuable to many students' future careers.
