<b>1 jurisdiction has a rule that allows either the Department or the track veterinarian can put a horse on the suspension list approved by the stewards.</b>		
<b>2 jurisdictions have rules that automatically require horses scratched by veterinarians to go a the veterinarian's list</b>		
<b>1 jurisdiction gives the Stewards the authority to decide if the horse goes on the Veterinarian's list</b>
