Seven jurisdictions have rules that call for the Official winning horse and any other horse ordered by the commission or the stewards (5 jurisdictions); the Stewards (1 jurisdiction); or the stewards, official veterinarian or the commission (1 jurisdiction).

One jurisdiction has a rule which calls for the unofficial winner and any other horses the stewards or commission representative designate

Ten jurisdictions have rules that call for the winner and any other horse chosen by the Stewards (5 jurisdictions); Commission or stewards (3 jurisdictions); state steward state veterinarian (1 jurisdiction); or the stewards, division or track veterinarian (1 jurisdiction).

Four jurisdictions have rules that state any horse may be set for testing, and does not mandate the winner, official winning horse, or the unofficial winner.

Seven jurisdictions have rules that contain criteria which is more detailed for choosing which horses are picked to go to for testing

One jurisdiction has a rule that simply says that at least one horse from each race shall go to the test barn.

One jurisdiction has a rule which says at least two horses, one of which is the winner, from each race shall go to the test barn

One jurisdiction has a rule that says the horses finishing first and any other horses designated by the stewards
